


## Notice of forthcoming works



 **Where:** Flood Street, King Street, Birmingham Street, Castle Hill

 **What:** Works to locate utility services

 **When:** Monday 29 October for approximately four weeks

The West Midlands Combined Authority has embarked upon an ambitious plan to regenerate the region and to provide new opportunities for residents and businesses. Central to this plan is the expansion of the Metro network which will triple in size by 2026, providing high quality, safe and dependable tram travel across much of the region. The Midland Metro Alliance has been appointed to deliver the Metro network throughout the region.

The Wednesbury to Brierley Hill Metro extension will provide new and improved public transport links throughout Sandwell and Dudley, allowing easy travel between residential properties and places of employment and education within the West Midlands.

In summer 2019 work is scheduled to upgrade and divert utility services (gas, water, electricity and telecom, for example). In order for this to take place we need to confirm the location of existing services over a four week period.

The works will include several small excavations to confirm the location of utilities across Dudley Town Centre. We expect to be working in each location separately and for no longer than three days. To allow our team to work safely and efficiently, lane restrictions may be in place where needed. For the duration of the works a temporary compound will be in place on Flood Street car parks. Work is not expected to cause excessive noise or disruption.
