

Notice of forthcoming works



 **Where:** Bridge Street

 **What:** Re-opening of Bridge Street and full closure of Paradise Circus Queensway

 **When:** Ongoing from mid-Jan 2019

As you may be aware, the Midland Metro Alliance have been undertaking works on Paradise Circus Queensway since September 2018. This notice is to highlight the forthcoming full closure of Paradise Circus Queensway as we prepare to excavate and waterproof it in advance of the installation of tram track for the Birmingham Westside Metro extension.

From mid-January, Bridge Street will re-open with a left turn out to Broad Street for HGVs only (12.6 ft) Monday – Friday who are servicing Bridge Street and Holliday Street (from the low bridge to Paradise Circus Queensway). From 10pm – 5am Friday to Sunday, Bridge Street will also be open with a left turn out to Broad Street to vehicles accessing Broad Street for the night time economy. Town Hall and BAM Nuttall access will continue to be via Brunel Street and Suffolk Street Queensway. We recommend that you advise any logistics services you use of these changes.

These changes will also provide an alternative route for taxis to access Broad Street (via Bridge Street) to serve the weekend night-time economy.
